Sealed proposals for the construction of Esker Park will be received by Delhi Charter Township at the Township Hall located at 4410 Holt Road, Holt, MI 48842, until 2:00 p.m., Local Time on Tuesday, November 20th, 2018, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

Approximately 2.84 acres of recreational park development consisting of a full depth HMA pavement access drive, HMA parking lot, gravel overflow parking lot, concrete curb and gutter, storm sewer, HMA multi-use path, permanent pavement markings and signs, site lighting, site landscaping, restroom facility, sanitary sewer, water service, pedestrian bridge, and floating dock with kayak launches.

Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of Thirty (\$30.00) Dollars, CHECK ONLY, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.
