STATE STREET AND GR RIVER WM
CITY OF HOWELL
LIVINGSTON COUNTY, MICHIGAN

The City of Howell will receive sealed bids at the City Clerk's office located at 611 East Grand River Avenue, Howell, Michigan until **10 a.m. on Tuesday, March 26, 2019**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids should be sealed in an envelope with "State Street Renovation & Grand River Water Main Replacement Project" marked on the outside.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting for all prospective bidders will be held in the Council Chambers at City Hall (611 E. Grand River Avenue, Howell, MI 48843) on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at 9:00 AM. Only those who attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting will be allowed to bid on this project.

Division A – State Street and Alley portion of project is receiving Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. The Contractor and Subcontractors on this portion of the project must comply with the CDBG contract provisions found in form HUD-4010, Executive Order 11246, as amended, Section 3 clause and the Davis-Bacon Act. See spec section 00900 for information.

Division B – Grand River Water Main is locally funded and therefore does not have to meet the above-mentioned requirements.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms will be available beginning at **12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 26, 2019** at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of forty-five (\$45.00) Dollars, check only, payable to "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars, check only, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Howell in the amount of five percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Howell. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

The City of Howell reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

Neither the City nor its Engineer will give verbal instructions or verbal answers to any inquiries regarding the meaning of drawings and/or specifications prior to the award of the contract. Any verbal statement regarding the projects plans/specifications by any persons associated with the City or its Engineer, prior to award, shall be unauthorative. Clarifications to bid documents shall be requested in writing via email to the Engineer (Andy Malczewski) at amalczewski@hrcengr.com. If clarification is deemed to be required, an addendum will be issued to all prospective bidders. The last day for contractor inquiries shall be 12:00 p.m. on **March 20, 2019**.

It is highly suggested that all prospective bidders perform their own site visit to review the conditions of the site and access.
