CITY OF EATON RAPIDS
HOSPITAL PUMP STATION UPGRADES
EATON COUNTY, MICHIGAN

Sealed proposals for the Hospital Pump Station Upgrades will be received by the City Clerk for the City of Eaton Rapids until 2:00 p.m., Local Time on Wednesday, December 4, 2019, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The project includes upgrades to the Hospital Street Pump Station, a sanitary pump station located within the City of Eaton Rapids wastewater system. The station, which is approximately 55 years old, is located near the intersection of Williams Street and Montgomery Street and collects sanitary flows from the Eaton Rapids Medical Center along with several residential and office building users within the service area.

The proposed improvements generally include demolishing the existing pumps, valves, and piping and replacing with a new above grade self-priming pump station housed within a 6'x6' enclosure installed on top of a new concrete slab above the existing wet well. The new equipment will include all of the pumps, motors, piping, valves, and controls equipment within a factory-assembled pump station. The improvements also include modifications to the existing wet well top slab, new suction piping within the wet well, replacement of the existing electrical and controls systems, and all pertinent restoration activities.

Copies of Plans and Specifications and Proposal Forms shall be available on or after 10:00 AM on November 12, 2019 at the offices of Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., Consulting Engineers, 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan 48302-0360.

A non-refundable payment of sixty (\$60.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY, payable to** "Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc." will be required for each set of Drawings and Specifications. Drawings and Specifications can be shipped by U.P.S. ground for a shipping and handling charge of fifteen (\$20.00) Dollars, **CHECK ONLY**, non-refundable, to Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc. The Bidder is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Bidder must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Eaton Rapids in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Eaton Rapids. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

All proposals shall be enclosed in sealed envelopes and labeled as indicated bellowed. If mailed, the sealed envelopes containing proposals shall be inserted in a separate mailing envelope labeled and addresses as follows:
