WATER TREATMENT PLANT - PHASE 1 IMPROVEMENTS
CITY OF SOUTH LYON, MI

Sealed proposals for the construction of these improvements will be received by mail addressed to the City Clerk for the City of South Lyon until 4:00 p.m., Local Time on May 21, 2020. The bids will be opened and read by the City on May 22, 2020.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

This Project consists of four (4) parts which require important construction phasing that will need to be followed to ensure that water production for the City can be maintained during this project.

- 1) The construction of a new 450 feet, 12-inch pipeline from Well 7 to the Water Treatment Plant (WTP).
- 2) The addition of a 600,000 Gallon Above Ground Storage tank to the WTP.
- 3) Repairing the Existing 1,000,000 Gallon Above Ground Storage tank onsite.
- 4) The replacement of filter media in six (6) Horizontal Pressure Filters at the WTP. This also includes applying a new sealant to the filters.

Plans and Specifications and Bid Proposal Forms shall be available on or after April 24, 2020 through the Michigan Intragovernmental Trade Network (MITN) www.bidnetdirect.com/mitn

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of South Lyon in the amount of five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of South Lyon. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least seven (7) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

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No Proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered by mail to the City of South Lyon Clerk on or before 4:00 pm, Local time, May 21, 2020. Bids are required to be submitted by mail to:
