Sealed proposals for the construction of the Influent Screen Replacement at the Wastewater Treatment Plant will be received by the City of Cheboygan, 403 North Huron Street, Cheboygan, MI 49721, until 1:00 p.m., Local Time on October 1, 2020, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

Bidders shall comply with the requirements of the State of Michigan Revolving Loan Funding requirements which are incorporated into the bidding documents.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The project consists of removal of the existing influent fine screen and installation of a new influent fine screen and washer compactor at the City's wastewater treatment plant, with associated demolition, concrete, mechanical and electrical work.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Cheboygan in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City. No bid may be withdrawn for 120 days after scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds, and Insurance Certificates.

The City of Cheboygan reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.
