

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS  
PRIORITY 1 AND 2 IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT  
SOUTH HURON VALLEY UTILITY AUTHORITY  
WAYNE COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

Sealed bids for the construction of the Priority 1 And 2 Improvements Project will be received by the South Huron Valley Utility Authority (SHVUA), SHV Wastewater Treatment Plant, 34001 W. Jefferson Ave., Brownstown, Michigan 48173 until **10:00 a.m., Local Time on Wednesday April 28, 2021**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

**Description of Work**

The following general areas of work will be performed:

- Civil paving, sidewalk, crack sealing, sewers, access gate and fence, manhole modification, truck loading access platform and site restoration
- Structural concrete surfaces repairs, coatings, expansion joint replacement and other repairs/modifications
- Architectural roof replacement, masonry pointing and repairs, doors replacement and painting
- Miscellaneous metals, including handrails, structural columns and beams, grating, etc.
- Process submersible pumps, grit vortex impeller pumps, rotary lobe sludge pumps, centrifugal SFE pumps and strainers, grit removal equipment and final clarifiers.
- Piping, valves and slide gates
- Mechanical H&V air handling units, roof-top units, ventilation fans, ancillary work and controls
- Emergency generators, MCCs, VFDs, disconnect panels, conduit and wiring, etc.
- Control panels, PLC replacement, software and algorithm migration, SCADA replacement and existing system controls integration
- Collection system submersible pump station and bypass pumping, flow meters and telemetry upgrades

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

**Proposal Guarantee**

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the bid forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the South Huron Valley Utility Authority in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Bid Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract within the hold period. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least 90 days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

**Award of Contract**

The South Huron Valley Utility Authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, select the successful qualified bidder, and to waive any informality or irregularities in bidding should it consider same to be in its best interest. The successful qualified bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, labor and material bonds, maintenance and guarantee bond and insurance polices.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

**Pre-Bid Meeting**

**In-Person Meeting.** A pre-bid meeting will be held at the South Huron Valley WWTP located at 34001 West Jefferson Avenue, Brownstown Township, Michigan, as stipulated below. Space is limited and reservations are required. The meeting will be held onsite in the Administrative Building Maintenance Garage. Temperatures will be spot checked at the door. Only two people per company may attend. Contractors may share tables at their own discretion. Michigan Social Distancing guidelines will be in effect, failure to follow Social Distancing Guidelines may result in expulsion from the premises. Face coverings are required. Representatives of the Owner and the Engineers will be present to discuss the Project. All Bidders are strongly encouraged to attend the meeting. The meeting will include a site tour. All those participating in the site tour are required to wear masks, hard hats, safety shoes, and safety glasses. Participants are requested to provide their own personal protective equipment.
