

**ADDENDUM NO. 1
TO SPECIFICATIONS FOR:
SAW SEWER CLEANING AND TELEVISIONING
ALGONAC, MICHIGAN**

This Addendum is issued prior to receipt of proposals to provide for certain changes and clarifications to the Specifications and/or the Drawings, as herein specified, and is hereby made a part of the Contract Documents and shall be taken into consideration in preparing the Proposal. All other conditions remain the same. **The Proposer shall acknowledge the receipt of this Addendum by signing below, including this addendum with their proposals, and completing the Addenda section of the Proposal Form (Section 00300).** Failure to sign the Addenda Section of the Proposal Form in the submission of the proposal may be justification for the proposal being rejected as non-responsive.

The following lists the extent of this Addendum. Descriptions of the changes or clarifications are given within each heading:

SPECIFICATION CHANGES:

- ≡ Section 0500, Paragraph 1: line beginning with "Item 2", project information changed to: "SAW Sewer Cleaning and Televising, City of Algonac, HRC Job No. 20200137."

Refer to updated Contract page with this Addendum.

PROSPECTIVE BIDDER QUESTIONS:

- ≡ Q: "Heavy cleaning, after 3 initial passes, does include "heavy" mineral deposit as part of the cost?"

A: Yes. As described in Section 02751, Should the sewer line have too much debris or blockage to allow a camera to pass through after the original three passes are made additional cleaning may be required. This work shall commence only upon the approval and direction of the Owner and/or the Owner's Representative/Engineer and will be defined as "Heavy Cleaning". The Owner shall pay for an additional "three-pass" cleaning of sewer pipelines utilizing high pressure jetting equipment, and mechanical cleaners such as bucket machines, scrapers, cutters and augers to allow for passage of the CCTV; removing obstructions and medium to large amounts of debris such as gravel, sand, rocks, grease and other deleterious materials within the sewer line; removal of mineral deposits in accordance with the cleaning standards detailed in Article 1.2.D and removal of all attached, or encrusted and hard compacted deposits; and removal of roots, root balls. *Heavy Cleaning as needed, ___-inch Diameter ____ [System-Type] Sewer (base bid amount), lft.* will be paid for at the contact unit price per foot measured from inside of manhole to inside of manhole.

- ≡ Q: "Water for cleaning....I have contacted the city DPW, but is there a charge for water to be used on the project?"

A: Water is available for use for this project from the City's Water Distribution System. There is no charge for water use, however the water use is required to be metered. The City may dictate which water hydrants are available for

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use on the project without reason. The City Water Department may provide a temporary construction backflow preventer with water meter, subject to their own provisions and requirements for use. The Contractor will be responsible for discussing their intended hydrant use with the DPW and winterizing/ pumping down the hydrants used as necessary.

Should a City hydrant connection assembly be unavailable for use, the contractor is required to provide a temporary hydrant construction meter connection with proper fittings, backflow prevention, tools, temporary hose, and meter. The contractor is responsible for the safe keeping of the connection, valve(s), or meter during its period of use. Any damage to existing fire hydrants outside of normal use is the responsibility of the contractor, and the contractor should review existing hydrant conditions with the City before use. The Contractor shall disconnect hoses from hydrant when not in use. The contractor is responsible for following safe potable water practices during hydrant use which includes providing proper air gap when filling tanks to prevent any backflow. Hydrant meter assemblies need to be supported while connected.

All existing gate valves and hydrants are to be operated only after approval by City of Algonac personnel only. The Contractor shall follow any policy declared by City for operating hydrants.

- ≡ Q: "Will the city restrict usage of certain hydrants....moving equipment to obtain water will dramatically slow down the project, and adding a water tanker will increase costs as well ?"

A: Yes, the City may restrict or dictate which hydrants are available to use on the project.

- ≡ Q: "There is no item for protruding tap removal....are we to assume there are none to remove?"

A: Removing protruding taps is not required for this project. Should a protruding tap be discovered, it shall be recorded using PACP coding on the CCTV survey. Should the protruding tap block the camera from passing or prevent the CCTV survey from being completed, the survey shall be abandoned and a reverse setup shall be attempted. The City does not have a record information of protruding taps.

- ≡ Q: "Is the Performance Bond, Labor & Materials bond required for this project?"

A: Yes, a Performance Bond, Maintenance & Guarantee Bond, and Labor & Materials Bond are required for this project. Refer to the contract documents 00610, 00620, and 00630.

- ≡ Q: "Also, it asks for Builders Risk Installation Floater... is that required for this project (seems odd requirement)? We are not building a structure?"

A: Refer to Section 00800. 1.6. A Builders Risk Floater is required for this municipal work.

1.6 Builder's Risk Installation Floater

A. The Contractor shall purchase a Builder's Risk Installation Floater in a form acceptable to the Owner covering property of the project for the full cost of replacement as of the time of any loss which shall include, as named insured, (a) the Contractor, (b) all Subcontractors, (c) all Sub Subcontractors, (d) the Owner, and the Engineer, as their respective interests may prove to be at the time of loss, covering insurable property which is the subject of this contract, whether in place, stored at the job site, stored elsewhere, or in transit at the risk of the insured(s).

B. Coverage shall be effected on an "All Risk" form including, but not limited to, the Perils of fire, wind, flood, vandalism, collapse, theft and earthquake, with exclusions normal to the cover.

- C. The Contractor may arrange for such deductibles as he deems to be within his ability to self assume, but he will be held solely responsible for the amount of such deductible and for any coinsurance penalties.
- D. Any insured loss shall be adjusted with the Owner and the Contractor and paid to the Owner and Contractor as trustee for the other insured.
