

**RED RUN DRAIN RESTORATION – PHASE 1  
RED RUN DRAIN, STERLING RELIEF DRAIN AND FREEDOM HILL RESTORATION  
MACOMB COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Office of the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner, Oakland County, Michigan, Building 95 West, One Public Works Drive, Waterford, Michigan 48328-1907 (“Owner”) for the construction of certain facilities and structures, including the following approximate quantities:

The Red Run Drain Restoration – Phase 1 project will include the installation of in-stream j-hook structures, stream bank stabilization, and minor dredging with restoration of native seed, plugs, and trees. The project also includes construction of a shared use non-motorized gravel path and native plantings along the Sterling Relief Drain and Red Run Drain from Schoenherr Road to Metropolitan Parkway.

**PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED AND PUBLICLY OPENED AND READ AT THE FOLLOWING DATE AND TIME: December 14, 2021 at 10:00 am**
