On behalf of the City of Cheboygan, sealed proposals for the SSES SANITARY SEWER CCTV INSPECTIONS project will be received **until 2:00 p.m., Local Time on Monday, February 28, 2022** at the offices of **Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc., 555 Hulet Drive, Bloomfield Hills, Michigan, 48302-0360, attention Jennifer Morreale, P.E.** The Prices will NOT be publicly opened and read, but rather will be collected and evaluated by the Engineer on behalf of the City. In addition to, but NOT in lieu of, electronic copies of proposals and bid documents may be submitted as PDF documents via email to Jennifer Morreale, P.E. at [jmorreale@hrcengr.com](mailto:jmorreale@hrcengr.com) until the same time and date indicated above. Following the bid opening, the bid tabulation will be posted to Hubbell, Roth & Clark's website under Bid Info ([hrcengr.com/bid-info/](http://hrcengr.com/bid-info/)).

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The project consists of sanitary sewer televising with sewer condition coding per the National Association of Sewer Service Companies (NASSCO) Pipe Assessment Certification Program (PACP). Condition assessment shall be performed by a NASSCO PACP certified individual with a current certification. The entire project area consists of a total of 163,800 linear feet (LF) ranging in size from 4- to 24-inch as follows:

1. 800 LF of 4-inch diameter sewer.
2. 142,000 LF of 6-inch to 12-inch diameter sewer.
3. 21,000 LF of 15-inch to 24-inch diameter sewer.

Project also includes sanitary sewer cleaning of up to 163,800 LF, ranging in size from 4- to 24-inch, where necessary.

Bidders are advised that to submit a proposal on this project, original documents purchased from Hubbell, Roth, & Clark, Inc. must be used.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

**Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.**

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Cheboygan in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Cheboygan. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of Cheboygan reserves the right to reject all prices and to waive irregularities. While cost is an important part of the selection process, the City reserves the right to award the project to the manufacturer from which the best value and product for the City can be delivered.

No Quotation will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered as described previously.
