

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
DIGESTER COVER REMOVAL PROJECT
CARO WWTP
CITY OF CARO, MICHIGAN

Sealed proposals for the construction of the cover removal project will be received by the City of Caro, 317 South State Street Caro, MI 48723, until 1:00 p.m., Local Time on Thursday March 24, 2022, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

Removal of a 55-ft diameter steel floating lid from the City of Caro WWTP's primary digester. Cover will be removed in one piece, placed on cribbing and pressure washed to facilitate inspection. Inspection will be conducted under a separate contract.

A pre-bid meeting will be held Wednesday March 9th at 1:00pm at the site, which is located at 724 Columbia St, Caro, MI 48723. Bidders are required to either attend this meeting or contact the City directly to arrange for a visit to the site.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to City of Caro in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City. No bid may be withdrawn for 90 days after scheduled closing time for receiving bids.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds, and Insurance Certificates

The City of Caro reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.
