

**2022 SEWER REHABILITATION PROGRAM
CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
OAKLAND COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Office of the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner, Oakland County, Michigan, Building 95 West, One Public Works Drive, Waterford, Michigan 48328-1907 ("Owner") for the construction of certain sewer system improvements, including the following approximate quantities:

Proposals will be received up to Monday, April 18, 2022 at 2:00 p.m., local time, at which time all bids will be publicly opened. This project will be evaluated on a qualification-based selection process. Each proposal will be evaluated and scored based on its price, workplan, staff experience, and schedule. As such, proposal prices will not be read at bid opening.
