12 MILE ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS

Sealed proposals for the construction of the 12 Mile Road Sidewalk Improvements Project will be received by the City of Wixom offices located at 49045 Pontiac Trail, Wixom, MI 48393, until **10 a.m. Local Time on October 3, 2023**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids must be sealed in an envelope with “12 Mile Road Sidewalk Improvements” marked on the outside.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

The City of Wixom officially distributes bid documents through the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN). Copies of documents obtained from any other source are not considered official copies. Only those vendors who obtain documents from the MITN system are guaranteed access to receive addendum information if such information is issued. If you obtained this document from a source other than MITN, it is recommended that you register on the MITN site, www.mitn.info and obtain an official copy and any addenda. The City of Wixom also reserves the right to use any other method of advertising and/or distributing bid information; however, any additional method of distribution will also direct vendors to MITN.

Questions, comments, or concerns of any bidder regarding bidding or the contract documents must be submitted in writing by 3:00 p.m. on **September 26, 2023**. No inquiry received after that date will be given consideration. Submit all questions to Engineer at:

Contractors or Subcontractors performing the work of this contract shall be required to submit previous relevant experience in order to be considered.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Wixom in the amount of five percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that

the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Wixom. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least sixty (60) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of Wixom reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.
