2026 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS  
DELHI CHARTER TOWNSHIP

Sealed proposals for the construction of the Delhi Charter Township 2026 Sidewalk Improvements will be received by Delhi Charter Township at the Township Hall, Clerk's Office located at 2074 Aurelius Road, Holt, Michigan 48842, until **11:00 AM Local Time on March 10, 2026**, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read. Bids must be sealed in an envelope with "2026 Sidewalk Improvements" marked on the outside.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

This project involves repair and improvements of existing municipal sidewalk, which includes the raising/leveling of uneven sidewalk slabs, the removal and replacement of damaged sidewalk slabs, and the construction of ADA compliant sidewalk ramps.

Obtaining Bid Documents

Information and Bid Documents for the Project shall be available on or after **February 13, 2026**, by emailing Brittany Covault at [bcovault@hrcenr.com](mailto:bcovault@hrcenr.com), who will provide a PDF copy of the documents via email or online link. Bid Documents may also be downloaded from MITA (Michigan Infrastructure & Transportation Association).

Prospective Bidders are urged to request to be recorded or register as a plan holder, even if Bid Documents are obtained from a plan room or source other than the designated link in either electronic or paper format. The designated link will be updated periodically with addenda, list of registered plan holders, reports, or other information relevant to submitting a Bid for the Project. All official notifications, addenda, and other Bid Documents will be offered only through the designated link. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bid Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated link.

Questions, comments, or concerns of any Bidder regarding bid or the contract documents must be submitted in writing by 3:00 pm on **March 3, 2026**. No inquiries received after that date will be considered. Submit all questions to:

Contractors or Subcontractors performing the work of this contract shall be required to submit previous relevant experience to be considered.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

**Each Bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.**

Each Bid Proposal shall be submitted on the Proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond, executed by the Bidder and Surety Company, payable to Delhi Charter Township in the amount of five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the Bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with Delhi Charter Township. No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

Delhi Charter Township reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.
