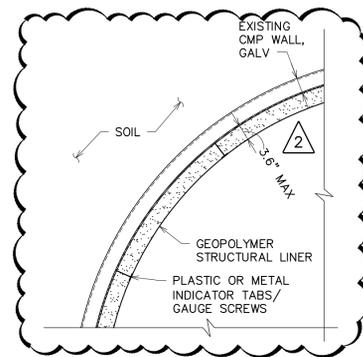

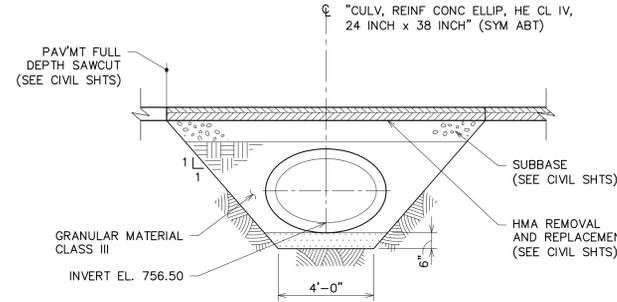

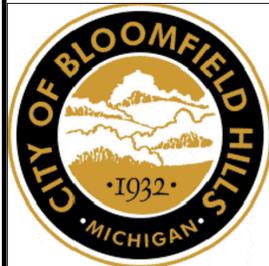
- 1. ALL CONSTRUCTION MUST CONFORM TO CURRENT MIOSHA SAFETY STANDARDS.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CONDUCT HIS OPERATIONS IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO ENSURE THAT NO DAMAGE SHALL COME TO THE EXISTING FACILITIES, UTILITIES AND ELEMENTS ADJACENT TO HIS WORK.
3. CONTRACTOR TO PROTECT THOSE EXISTING ELEMENTS DESIGNATED TO REMAIN. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF ANY ELEMENTS DAMAGED DURING CONSTRUCTION.

7. THE CONTRACTOR'S PREPARATION AND SUBMISSION INFORMATION, CERTIFICATION, DATA SHEETS, SHOP DRAWINGS, ETC. FOR ENGINEERS APPROVAL OF ALL MATERIALS USED SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE PROJECT AND SHALL NOT BE PAID FOR SEPARATELY.
8. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL LOCATE ALL ACTIVE UNDERGROUND UTILITIES PRIOR TO STARTING WORK AND SHALL CONDUCT HIS OPERATIONS IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO ENSURE THAT THOSE UTILITIES NOT REQUIRING RELOCATION WILL NOT BE DISTURBED.
9. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CALL MISS DIG (800-482-7171) A MINIMUM OF 72 HOURS (3 WORKING DAYS) PRIOR TO THE START OF CONSTRUCTION.
10. CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE ALL WORK WITH OWNER PRIOR TO INSTALLATION OR FABRICATION OF ANY COMPONENTS.
11. CONTRACTOR SHALL BECOME FAMILIAR WITH AND COMPLY WITH ALL OWNER REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS.
12. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL KEEP THE SITE IN A NEAT AND ORDERLY CONDITION AND SHALL REMOVE RUBBISH DAILY OR AS DIRECTED BY THE OWNER. 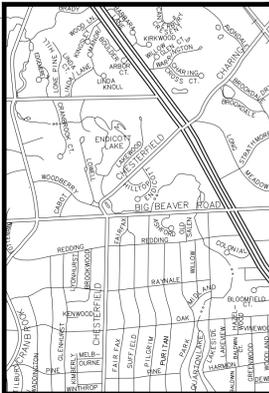

Sealed proposals for the construction of the Chesterfield Road Culvert Rehabilitation will be received by the City of Bloomfield Hills until 10:00 a.m., Local Time on Wednesday, April 8, 2026, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read.

Bidders shall review and comply with the Instructions to Bidders, which are incorporated by reference, and carefully review all Contract Documents, as defined in the Instructions to Bidders. Bids submitted after the exact time specified for, receipt will not be considered.

The Contracts will consist of the following principal items of work and appurtenances as specified herein and shown on the Contract Drawings.

Description of Work

The Project includes rehabilitation of two twin culverts on Chesterfield Road in Bloomfield Hills, Michigan. The Project requires geopolymer structural liner for the existing culverts, a new concrete elliptical culvert, guardrail and road repairs, and other miscellaneous items as indicated in the Proposal.

Bidders may obtain a copy of the Drawings and Specifications (Procurement Documents) for the project through either the MITN website, or by contacting HRC directly at lmichaels@hrcengr.com.

Proposals submitted by Bidders who have been debarred, suspended, or made ineligible by any Federal Agency will be rejected.

Each bidder agrees to waive any claim it has or may have against the Owner, the Architect/Engineer, and their respective employees, arising out of or in connection with the administration, evaluation, or recommendation of any bid.

Each bid proposal shall be submitted on the proposal forms provided and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond, executed by the bidder and Surety Company, payable to the City of Bloomfield Hills in the amount of Five Percent (5%) of the accompanying bid. Proposal Guarantee shall provide assurance that the bidder will, upon acceptance of the bid, execute the necessary Contract with the City of Bloomfield Hills. No bid may be withdrawn after scheduled closing time for receiving bids for at least ninety (90) days.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory insurance documentation, and Performance, Labor and Material, and Maintenance and Guarantee Bonds.

The City of Bloomfield Hills reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive irregularities in bidding.

Also, the Owner reserves the right to reject the bid of any Bidder if the Owner believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder, whether because the bid is not responsive or the Bidder is unqualified, of doubtful financial ability, or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by the Owner.

FEES

The Bidder shall refer to the General Conditions for allowable Fees for additional work performed, upon Owner's written authorization, by Bidder's own forces and/or for additional work, upon Owner's written authorization, by Bidder's subcontractors.

TIME OF COMPLETION

If awarded the Contract for the Chesterfield Road Culvert Rehabilitation project, we agree to have all work substantially completed by **Friday, October 30, 2026**. Substantial Completion is defined that the facility is ready to use for its intended purpose with all utility systems fully functional.

Final Completion with all clean-up and punch-list items shall be completed by **Friday, November 13, 2026**.

The Bidder hereby agrees to furnish the required Bonds, Insurance Certificates, and Policies within ten (10) days after acceptance of this Proposal.

The execution of all work and specific constraints as described in the contract drawings and specifications, with particular reference to Section 01001 – Supplemental Project Requirements, must be strictly adhered to.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

Time is of the essence for completion of this project in order to have the Project ready for the City of Bloomfield Hills. The Bidder guarantees that the work will be completed within the time limit stated herein before or within the time as extended as provided elsewhere in the Specifications. Inasmuch as the damage and loss to the Owner which will result from the failure of the Bidder to complete the work within the stipulated time, will be most difficult or impossible to accurately determine, it is mutually agreed that the damages to the Owner for such delay and failure on the part of the Bidder shall be liquidated in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), for each and every

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calendar day by which the Bidder shall fail to complete the work or any part thereof within the provisions hereof, and such liquidated damages shall not be considered as a penalty.

The Owner will deduct and retain out of any money due or to become due hereunder the amount of the liquidated damages, and in case those amounts are less than the amount of actual liquidated damages, the Bidder shall pay the difference upon demand of the Owner.

We understand that liquidated damages may be assessed should we fail to meet the stipulated completion dates. Specifically, liquidated damages will be assessed daily beginning the next business day after the date stipulated herein, or as mutually agreed upon, until as such time that Substantial Completion is achieved, and further work is not completed by the Final Completion Date.

BIDS TO REMAIN FIRM

The price stated in this Proposal shall be guaranteed for a period of not less than ninety (90) days from the bid due date and if authorized to proceed within that period, the bidder agrees to complete the work covered by the Proposal at said price.

If this Proposal is accepted by the Owner and the undersigned shall fail to contract as aforesaid and to furnish the required surety bonds within fourteen (14) days after being notified of the acceptance of their bid, then the undersigned shall be considered to have abandoned the contract, and the Certified Check, Cashier's Check or Bid Bond accompanying this Proposal shall be forfeited to the City of Bloomfield Hills.

If the undersigned enters into the contract in accordance with their proposal, or if their proposal is not accepted, then the accompanying bid guarantee shall be returned to the undersigned.
